In December of 2019, she was additionally tasked with serving as Director for the Licensing and Data Quality program for the Texas Department of Agriculture and is also over the agency's licensing of all regulatory programs. Also, Christina oversees the Texas metrology lab located in Giddings, Texas. She works with the metrology lab manager and staff, Consumer Product Protection program staff, and TDA field staff to ensure the Texas Department of Agriculture makes every effort to provide equity in the marketplace.

As part of her time as a regulatory official at another Texas state agency, Christina spent 10 years at the Texas General Land Office, as an inspector; lease, easement, contract and property manager where her main job function was to lease state lands for hunting, grazing and oil and gas production.
