## Verified Conformity Assessment Program Considerations Caused by the COVID-19, Pandemic Revised October 12, 2021

This letter is to inform all companies holding an active NTEP Certificate of Conformance, for a device type included in the Verified Conformity Assessment Program (VCAP), of considerations for extension to your VCAP compliance audit deadline.

A decision was made that virtual audits would not be considered, however; considering the current situation regarding international travel restrictions and facility access restrictions, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, an extension to the compliance date may be possible if:

- A VCAP auditor cannot visit your facility because of international travel or facility visitor restrictions related to the pandemic, or
- Any international audit currently scheduled, must be postponed, because of issues related to the pandemic.

These considerations apply to currently scheduled audits or audits that were/are to have been conducted between March 1, 2020 and March 31, 2022.

NTEP will continue to inform customers of their audit due date and if both parties agree, the audit will be scheduled. Should a circumstance arise that places a recognized VCAP auditor in a customer's facility, for any reason, that is past their VCAP audit due date, the audit must be conducted at that time.

This extension applies only to audits that must be conducted outside the USA. No additional time extension will apply to any domestic (within the USA) audit other than a delay caused by scheduling conflicts of the auditing firm or the auditor.

The audit extension would apply to original audit due dates as shown in the table below.
